

APPLICATION FOR WILDFIRE RECOVERY ON PRIVATE PARCELS BURNED BY WILDFIRES THAT OCCURRED IN SHASTA COUNTY BETWEEN 2019-2021.

The main goal of this project is to identify, prioritize, and implement wildfire rehab treatments on up to 35 private properties affected by the wildfires in Shasta County that occurred from 2019-2021, including but not limited to the Zogg Fire (2020), the Salt Fire (2021) and the Fawn Fire (2021), in order to reduce the impacts and facilitate the recovery process.

The "Wildfire Rehab Private Property Site Assessments & Treatments" will include the following objectives:

- Wildfire Rehab Property Assessments: WSRCD Staff will conduct site assessments on private
 properties with willing landowners. Site Assessments will include property walkthroughs with
 landowners to collect information about the property and develop fire rehab recommendations
 such as erosion control, replanting natives, identifying/treating invasive weeds, hazard tree
 removal, and any other recommendations that will help with property recovery.
- Wildfire Rehab Property Treatments: WSRCD Staff will implement fire rehab treatments on up to 35 private properties with willing landowners in order to reduce impacts to and facilitate recovery.
